November 22, 2019

A Washington County resident came to the sheriff's office to talk to deputies about a child custody issue. After investigation it was determined that the matter was civil.

November 23, 2019

Deputies received a call about a juvenile trying to run away from home. Deputies talked to the juvenile and left the juvenile with a guardian.

November 24, 2019

Deputies were notified of two juveniles that were provided marijuana by another juvenile. The case is under investigation.

Deputies received a call about a burglary in the 8500 block of CO RD W. The house and fifth wheel motor home had been broken into. Case is under investigation.

November 25, 2019

Deputies were dispatched to a house fire in the 40 block of Cedar. There were no injuries and the cause of the fire appeared to be an electrical short in the wiring of an exhaust fan.

Deputies were dispatched to a disturbance at the Event Center in the Town of Akron. Upon further investigation it was determined that Aaron Valdez and James Atwood had engaged in a physical altercation. Both individuals received a summons for disorderly conduct.

November 26, 2019

Deputies were notified of an incident that occurred on November 23, 2019 where three juveniles were making prank calls that incited investigations from the Limon Police Department, Holyoke Police Department and Phillips County Sheriff's Office as well as our department. Case is under investigation.

November 27, 2019

Deputies received a call about two dogs at large in the 200 block of Cedar Ave in the Town of Akron. One of the dogs had been hit by a car and didn't make it; the other dog was given back to the owner. The owner was given a verbal warning for dog at large.

Deputies responded to a one vehicle rollover on Hwy 36 & CO RD TT. The driver was checked by medical and had no injuries. The driver, Emmanuel Barrois was later arrested on a warrant. He was transported to Washington County Justice Center and later released on a \$2,500.00 bond.

Deputies received a call from Golden Police Department on a stolen motorcycle believed to be in Washington County. Deputies are still attempting to locate the motorcycle.

Deputies were dispatched to a rollover accident east of Otis. When deputies arrived on scene they spoke with both parties in the vehicle and determined that they had minor injuries. Deputies did not cite the driver due to adverse road conditions being a factor in the crash.
