

# WASHINGTON COUNTY

12/13/19 through 12/20/19

December 13, 2019

Deputies received a report of vandalism that occurred the night of December 12, 2019 in the 700 block of Birch Ave. After investigation, deputies issued a citation to a juvenile for destruction of private property.

Deputies received a report of someone throwing rocks at the neighbor's garage door. After further investigations it was determined that the marks on the garage door had been there for some time. No criminal charges were filed.

While in custody, Nicholas Geister was arrested on a Larimer County warrant for failure to appear. Geister is being held on a \$500.00 bond.

December 15, 2019

Deputies received a report of 2 vehicles being written on with chalk. There was no damage to the vehicles.

December 16, 2019

Deputies were dispatched to a welfare check on a female and her children in the Town of Akron. Deputies check on the parties and everyone was okay.

December 17, 2019

Deputies were dispatched to a structure fire in the 27000 block of Hwy 63. When deputies arrived the shed was totally engulfed in flames. Akron Volunteer Fire Department arrived on scene and extinguished the fire. The shed was a total loss and it appears that it was accidental.

Deputies initiated a traffic stop on a vehicle on Hwy 34 & CO RD L. It was determined that the vehicle was stolen out of Adams County. The driver gave 3 different names during the stop. The driver was eventually identified as Christopher Wilkes. Wilkes was arrested for 2<sup>nd</sup> degree aggravated motor vehicle and false reporting to authorities. Wilkes is being held on a \$15,000.00 bond.

Deputies were notified of a possible animal cruelty in the Town of Akron. Deputies checked on the animals and observed no animal cruelty.

While in custody, Corey Tyler was arrested on a warrant out of Adams County District Court. Tyler is being held on a \$10,000.00 bond.

December 18, 2019

Deputies received a report of an unknown male making inappropriate propositions towards a woman in the parking lot of JD's Quik Stop. Case is under investigation.

Deputies arrested Cory Grooms on a warrant out of Morgan County. Grooms was later transported to Morgan County Jail.
