December 27, 2019

Deputies received a report of a dog attack in the Town of Akron. Upon further investigation, Mark Hart was cited for vicious dog 1st offense.

During the latter part of December, Washington County Sheriff's Office has received several reports of drones flying around the county. The Sheriff's Office is still investigating what the drones are doing.

December 28, 2019

Deputies received a report of phone harassment in the Town of Akron. Case is under investigation.

Deputies responded to the 40 block of Elm Ave in the Town of Akron for a stray cat. The cat was taken to the pound and later claimed. The owner, Paula Lefforge was given a verbal warning for animal at large.

December 30, 2019

Deputies received a call about a dog at large in the 400 block of E 11th St in the Town of Akron. The dog was taken to the pound and later claimed. The owner, Dillon Armstrong will be cited for dog at large 5th offense.

Deputies were dispatched to a disturbance call in the Town of Akron. After investigation, Aaron Valdez was arrested and charged with harassment, trespassing, criminal mischief and assault. Valdez is being held on a \$3,000.00 bond.

December 31, 2019

Deputies received a report of a stolen yard decoration in the 500 block of Fremont in the Town of Akron. Case is under investigation.

January 2, 2020

Deputies were notified of a high speed pursuit from Yuma County. The vehicle was eventually recovered behind Davis Brothers. Uriel Ureno-Garcia was observed leaving the vehicle and taken into custody and turned over to the Colorado State Patrol. After further investigation Ureno- Garcia was released and no charges were filed by Colorado State Patrol as he was not considered a suspect in the case. A short time later two vehicles were stolen from the YW parking lot. Deputies observed the vehicles driving west on Hwy 34 and pursued them onto I-76. Lucinda Mata was eventually taken into custody for 2nd degree aggravated motor vehicle theft, driving under revocation, possession of a schedule 2 controlled substance, speeding 25-39 mph over posted speed, vehicular eluding and reckless driving. Mata is being held pending advisement. The other suspect was able to elude deputies and the pursuit was called off. At this time one vehicle has been recovered the other has not yet been recovered.

Deputies were notified of a possible domestic violence outside of Otis. Case is under investigation.
