January 3, 2020

Deputies issued several abatements in the Town of Otis for overgrown trees hanging in the alley.

Deputies received a call from Yuma Police Department about a locating a cell phone in Washington County. Deputies went to the location where the cell phone was last known to be and it was an abandoned farmhouse and the effort to find the cell phone was unsuccessful.

Deputies received a report of harassment. Both parties involved were interviewed and nothing criminal had occurred.

Deputies arrested Howard Underwood for a probation violation out of Logan County. Underwood was later released on a \$200.00 bond.

Deputies received a call about an aggressive dog that had occurred sometime in December. Case is under investigation.

January 4, 2020
