January 10, 2020

Deputies were dispatched to Anton Supers on a possible theft/vandalism. Case is under investigation.

Deputies observed a dog at large in the 400 block of Date in the Town of Akron. Zella Goodman was later cited for dog at large.

Deputies were notified of a party that was found unconscious and not breathing in the Town of Akron. It was determined that the party likely died of natural causes. The coroner took over the scene.

While in custody, Venacio Montoya was arrested on a warrant out of Boulder County Court. Montoya bonded out on a \$2500.00 bond and later transported to DRDC.
