

# WASHINGTON COUNTY

Press Release

01/17/20 through 01/24/20

January 17, 2020

Deputies received a report of a possible harassment case in Washington County. After deputies completed the investigation it was determined that nothing criminal had occurred.

Deputies were dispatched to a trespass in the Cope area. Upon arrival to the location, Chad Wagner was arrested on a warrant. Deputies also towed the vehicle Mr. Wagner was in due to not having the correct registration. A search warrant was obtained for the vehicle and narcotics and narcotic equipment was found in the vehicle. Mr. Wagner was later released on a \$500.00 PR bond.

January 18, 2020

Deputies received a report of telephone harassment. After further investigation it was determined that there was not enough evidence to charge anyone.

January 19, 2020

Deputies were dispatched to the 400 block of Logan in the Town of Otis on a possible fraud by telephone. Case is under investigation.

While patrolling the Town of Akron deputies observed a vehicle leaving the Event Center at a high rate of speed. Deputies followed the vehicle and observed it swerve into oncoming traffic twice in less than a mile. Deputies made a traffic stop on the vehicle and discovered that the driver was intoxicated. Deputies arrested Fernando Juan Ixcoy for a DUI. The passengers in the vehicle were also intoxicated. Juan Valdez, Pablo Dominguez and a male juvenile were issued Minor in Possessions. Valdez and Dominguez were released on a summons; the juvenile was later released to a parent.

Deputies received a report of a possible domestic violence involving a weapon. After further investigation, deputies obtained an arrest warrant for the party.
