January 24, 2020

Deputies were dispatched to a family disturbance in Washington County. Upon arrival deputies spoke with the parties and determined nothing criminal had occurred.

Deputies were dispatched to a traffic accident on 1st & Cedar in the Town of Akron. After investigating the accident, Andrew Strishock was issued a citation for disregarding stop sign at a through street.
