February 7, 2020

Deputies received a call about an aggressive dog in the 600 block of Fremont. Deputies were unable to locate the dog.

Deputies were dispatched to a vehicle fire on Hwy 34 east of Akron. During investigation it was determined the driver of the vehicle had an active warrant out of Washington County Court. Saul Najjar was arrested and transported to the Washington County Justice Center. Najjar was later released on a \$500.00 bond.

Deputies received a report of a possible theft. After further investigation, it was determined to be a civil issue.
