February 14, 2020

Deputies issued several abatements in the Town of Akron and the Town of Otis.

Deputies were dispatched to the 40000 block of County Road 10 for an assault that had occurred earlier in the day. Deputies located Bo Dutton and placed him under arrest. Dutton was transported to Washington County Justice Center and was later released after accepting a plea agreement.

February 15, 2020

Deputies received a report of a motorist who was somewhere on Hwy 36 and was needing medical help. Deputies located the party and medical personnel transported the party to a local hospital.

Deputies received a report of a parking complaint in the Town of Otis. Upon arrival the vehicles were moved by the owner.

February 17, 2020

Deputies received a report from an Akron resident about possible harassment on Facebook. Deputies determined nothing criminal had occurred and no further action was taken at this time.

Deputies were dispatched to a residence in the Town of Akron with regard to a parking issue involving a vehicle parked in the alley that was creating difficulty for another to back out of their garage. There have been previous issues between the neighbors. No further action was taken at this time.

Deputies were informed a mental health issue in the Town of Akron. Deputies transported the party to the Washington County Sheriff's Office and had the party speak to Centennial Mental Health.

February 18, 2020

Deputies arrested Dave Hardy on a warrant out of Washington County Sheriff's Office for protection order violation. Hardy was later released on a \$500.00 bond.

Deputies received a report of a possible assault at the Otis School. Case is under investigation.

February 19, 2020

Deputies received a driving complaint in the Town of Akron. A silver van had passed a school bus while the lights were flashing. Case is under investigation.

February 20, 2020

Deputies were dispatched to a suicidal party in the Town of Akron. When deputies arrived on scene they noticed superficial injuries to the party's arm. The party was transported to the hospital for evaluation and treatment.

Deputies were notified of a young couple with an infant who were stranded in the Town of Akron with no money and no place to stay for the night. Deputies were able to arrange for the couple to stay in a motel room for the night.
