03/20/20 through 03/27/20

March 20, 2020

Deputies were dispatched to the 80 block of Cedar on a verbal disturbance. When deputies arrived the parties had separated and nothing criminal had occurred.

Deputies received a driving complaint at Bent Ave and Railroad Ave. The reporting party said a juvenile took a turn at a high rate of speed kicking up rocks due to the road being wet. The reporting party was able to identify the juvenile. The juvenile was cited for careless driving.

Deputies received a call of an intoxicated subject in the Town of Otis. The party was located at his residence and was okay.
