03/27/20 through 04/03/20

March 27, 2020

Deputies received a report of a vehicle theft in Washington County. After further investigation, it was determined that the matter was a civil dispute and the involved parties had resolved the matter without further incident.

Deputies responded to a child custody issue in the 300 block of Spruce St in the Town of Otis. The parties were advised that it was a civil matter and to contact the courts.

March 28, 2020

Deputies and Akron Volunteer Fire Department were dispatched to a smoke investigation in the 200 block of 3rd St. After investigation, it was determined that the smoke was coming from a pan that was left on a hot stove.

Deputies were called to a disturbance in the 700 block of E 1st St in the Town of Akron. Deputies arrested Skye Anderson on 3rd degree assault and domestic violence. Anderson was later released on a \$1,000.00 bond.

March 30, 2020

Deputies were dispatched to an unattended death in the 35000 block of County Road 41. Upon arrival they discovered that the male party had no vital signs present. The coroner took over the scene.

Deputies received a report of an online scam via Facebook messenger. Deputies spoke with the victim and discovered that she had given out identifying information and \$200.00. The victim was advised to monitor her credit and bank account.

Deputies were dispatched to assist Logan County for a suicidal party at Prewitt Reservoir. When deputies arrived at the reservoir, they assisted Logan County in apprehending the subject who had an unrelated warrant out of Sterling.

While at the Prewitt reservoir deputies observed a cloud of smoke rising in the air. Deputies located the smoke which was an unattended controlled burn that was beginning to get out of control. Hillrose Fire Department was called in and extinguished the fire. The party that started the controlled burn was located and warned that he couldn't be burning as there is a current fire ban in place.

Deputies were dispatched to a welfare check on a party with mental health issues that had left her residence. Deputies found the party and had her speak to a crisis worker. She was taken back to her house after she was done with the crisis worker.

Deputies arrested Armando Rascon on a warrant out of Washington County for Unlawful Sexual Contact.

Rascon was later released on a PR Bond.

April 1, 2020

Deputies were dispatched to a tractor fire in the 25000 block of County Road 41. It was determined that the fire started accidentally.

April 2, 2020

A wallet was turned in the Sheriff's Office that a party had found on Hwy 63. The wallet was later returned to the owner.
