April 10, 2020

Deputies were dispatched to a domestic violence in the 46000 block of CO RD JJ. Deputies spoke with the victim and arrested Jeffrey Ballard on charges of 3rd degree assault, domestic violence and child abuse. Ballard was later arrested on a \$500.00 PR bond.

April 11, 2020

Deputies contacted a suspicious person on the east end of Akron. The party claimed to have been kidnapped from Las Vegas and was held in Akron for 3 days. The party didn't want any assistance from the Sheriff's Office so deputies released the party.

April 13, 2020

Deputies received a report of a possible protection order violation in Washington County. Upon further investigation it was determined that no violation had occurred.

April 14, 2020

Deputies received a report from Department of Human Services on a possible elder exploitation that occurred in the Town of Akron. Case is under investigation.

Deputies received a report of a suspicious vehicle located on Hwy 34 at CO RD GG. Deputies found the vehicle to be abandoned on Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railroad property. BNSF had the vehicle towed off of their property.

Deputies received a report of a house being shot at by a BB gun in the Town of Akron. Upon arrival to the residence deputies didn't find any damage to the house and were unable to locate a vehicle described by the resident.

April 15, 2020

Deputies issued abatement to a residence in the Town of Akron for accumulation of refuse.

Deputies received a report of a possible sexual assault that had occurred in Yuma County. Deputies referred the party to report the incident to Yuma County.

A party brought a dog to the Washington County Sheriff's Office and deputies took it to the Akron Pound. The dog was later picked up by the owner and given a verbal warning.

While in custody, Tarence Wade was arrested on a warrant out of Gilpin County for failure to appear. Wade is being held on a \$500.00 bond.
