April 18, 2020

Deputies were notified of a gas drive off from Ison Oil in Platner. The party was contacted and returned to pay for the gas.

Deputies received a call of a dog at large in the Town of Akron. The dog was taken the pound and the owner, Kathryn Hayek claimed the dog and was issued a citation for dog at large.

April 19, 2020

Deputies were dispatched to a domestic violence in the Town of Akron. When deputies arrived on scene the suspect had left the residence and a warrant was obtained. Dylan Mills was later arrested and transported to the Washington County Justice Center for charges of 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree assault, crime of a protection order, and domestic violence.
